Residence hall spaces (Q, Y, W, X)	7:30 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday through Friday except for official university holidays when all university offices are closed. CSU permits are not valid during home Football game days at Canvas stadium, except in designated repark areas.
Meridian Village Lot 473 (X-Z)	
Extended enforcement A spaces	Lots 310, 350, and 425 have specially signed A spaces where enforcement is extended until 8 p.m. Lot 180 has A spaces that are enforced at all times.
ADA, J, B, CSU Apartment Permits (I, T, U)	Enforced 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
South College Parking Garage	Floor 1 hourly payment, floors 2-4 Z permit and hourly payment. Enforced 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
Lake Street Parking Garage	Floor 1 hourly payment, floor 2 A permit, floors 3-4 Z permit. Enforced 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
Moby Arena lot 195 and 197 (A, V, and Hourly)	Moby Arena is a special event lot. Parking is restricted during special event dates. Lot 195 has mixed permitting use as signed in the lot. Lot 197 is designated for hourly use requiring mobile or pay station payment.
Foothills Campus (Hourly and all permits except R)	Spaces on Foothills Campus are designated for permit or hourly use requiring a valid CSU permit or hourly payment.
All other spaces not detailed above (A, Z, V, R, and Hourly)	Enforced 7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday, or as designated on signage at the entrance or in the parking areas, except for official university holidays when all university offices are closed. CSU permits are not valid during home Football game days at Canvas stadium.

Short-term e-scooter and e-bike rentals on and off campus. Unlock with the app and park at any public bike rack.


Bike Storage

CSU provides two bike storage areas for your use, located at University Station and the Lake Street Garage. For more details on purchasing a bike storage permit, please contact CSU Transportation.



**Campus Parking**

- CSU Transportation is a self-funded auxiliary department of Colorado State University. No tax revenue, general funds, student fees, or tuition monies are received or used to support parking on campus and the CSU Transportation budget. Paid parking is required on Colorado State University campuses.
- Designated parking areas are signed, striped, or both. Posted signs in parking areas inform users and regulate authorized parking permits in the area. Please visit colostate.edu/transportation for a detailed explanation of parking regulations.
- CSU electric vehicle chargers are available on the Main, South and Foothills Campus, a Chargepoint account and valid payment are required, see signage at the spaces for payment requirements. Vehicles may charge for up to 4 hours and must be actively charging while parked in an EV space.
- Visit colostate.edu/transportation for parking regulations, transportation information, and other guidelines or visit Parking and Transportation Services during office hours Monday-Friday.
- CSU parking regulations are approved by the Board of Governors in accordance with the authority of Colo. Rev. Stat. §§ 23-5-106 through 108.

- CSU students living off campus can purchase permits to park in Z, V, or R spaces.
- Hourly parking is available on campus for staff, students, and visitors. Payment can be made using the mobile app or at pay stations in the lot. CSU parking permits are not valid in hourly parking spaces.
- CSU parking permits are not valid during home football games and Residence Hall students are required to repark to designated parking areas.
- Parking areas are enforced over summer, fall, winter, spring, and holiday breaks.
- ADA parking is available with a state issued ADA placard or ADA license plate and valid CSU parking permit or pay to park in an hourly designated space.
- Visitors can purchase daily parking permits online to park in Z, V, or R permitted spaces or pay by the hour to park in designated hourly parking spaces.
- CSU students living on campus in residence halls or apartment housing can purchase permits valid for their designated residence hall or apartment location.
- Aggie Village apartments have limited parking availability. Parking permits are sold by waitlist status only.

**Courtesy Shuttles**

CSU provides an on-demand shuttle service for students between main campus and the University Center for the Arts. Students can book rides through the CSU Shuttle app.



CSU offers a first-come, first-served shuttle service for students with eligible mobility disabilities. Apply through the Student Disability Center to check eligibility. Book rides using the CSU Courtesy Shuttle app.

**ParkMobile**

Parking in designated hourly parking spaces is made easier with the mobile app. Select the amount of time you want to park in the app and pay directly with a credit card. If you need to park longer, you may extend the time using the app without walking back to your car to pay the hourly pay station. The app is only valid in hourly parking spaces and not valid in permit designated areas.
